

Church Hall Update...



For the past few months, we have been working with local architectural firm Wilkins ADP to come up with a design for our new church hall. This design is based on the information we received from parishioners and different parish ministry groups from the surveys we conducted in 2016 and 2022, as well as numerous discussions and presentations within our parish community. Priorities in the new church hall design include: <u>Handicap accessibility</u> to the hall, and from the hall, into the church; fellowship space and kitchen; classrooms and educational space.

We want to build something that reflects the beauty and aesthetic of our current church building and will last just as long! Most especially, we want to build something that will make all those who have come before us—our fathers and mothers and grandfathers and grandmothers in the faith—proud of

what we have built in their honor! A new hall will be expensive. Exactly how expensive is difficult to say at this point due to the fluctuating costs of construction materials. Our current estimates are approximately \$2.5 million for the fellowship hall, kitchen, and bathrooms, and approximately \$1 million for the educational wing with four classrooms, a meeting room, and the priest's office.

Our desire is to build the entire hall at one time due to the many needs we have in our growing parish! However, we



have purposefully designed the hall to be able to be built in two phases <u>if needs</u> <u>be</u>. How we proceed will depend on whatever God wills and blesses! We know that with God, all things are possible. We also know that time and time again, we have experienced His great blessings through your incredible
