


### Church Hall Floor Plan...

We are excited to announce plans for our Saint George Church Hall project! We have been working with local architectural firm <u>Wilkins</u> <u>ADP</u> to come up with a design for our new church hall that will reflect the beauty and look of our current church building and will be built to last just as long! Priorities in our new church hall design include:

- Handicap accessibility to both the hall and the church
- Fellowship space for 160 people
- Classrooms and educational space
- Large kitchen
- Courtyard for additional outdoor fellowship space

Our hope is to build the entire hall at one time due to the many needs of our growing parish! However, we have purposefully designed the hall to be able to be built in two phases <u>if needs be</u>. Current estimates:

- Phase 1 (handicap access to the church, fellowship hall, kitchen, bathrooms): approximately \$2.5 million.
- Phase 2 (classrooms, conference room, and priest's office): approximately \$1 million.

#### Christ is risen!

We have received your letter of April 30, 2023, in which you request our blessing to begin a capital campaign to raise funds for construction of a new church hall. You state in your letter that the new addition would provide handicap access to the church as well as new fellowship space, a kitchen, classrooms, an office, and a meeting room. You further state that your goal is to complete the project within five years, depending on the success of your fundraising efforts. Additionally, you provided conceptual drawings for our review and minutes of a Special Meeting of your parish General Assembly on April 23, 2023, at which the proposed capital campaign was approved (63 in favor; 3 opposed).

Having reviewed your plans, drawings, and minutes, we are very pleased with your proposal. We do bless you to proceed with this capital campaign. When you are ready to build, please update us on your plans and request a blessing to proceed. Additionally, please note that you must also seek our blessing before undertaking any loan for this project. Since your annual parish income is limited, we hope that you will be able either to fund this project with cash in hand or to proceed with only a small loan, at most. We look forward to hearing of good results from your fundraising and to one day see this exciting project come to fruition.


